NARRATIVE SECTION

On 08/19/2010, the Illinois State Police (ISP), Zone 2 Investigations were requested by the East Moline Police Department (EMPD) to investigate allegations of delivery of alcohol to a minor and inappropriate contact with a minor by Jeff NMI Terronez (M/H,DOB:[REDACTED])

On 08/19/2010, at 8:40 PM, S/A S. Seas #5153 and I (Sgt. J. Costliow #3795) met with [REDACTED] (F/U, DOB: [REDACTED]) at [REDACTED] East Moline, IL (the residence of [REDACTED] . The purpose of the meeting was to interview [REDACTED] as to her observations and recollections of 08/15/2010 as it would relate to the captioned investigation. The following is a synopsis of the interview which will be followed by a verbatim transcription of the recorded interview.

[REDACTED] advised that prior to 08/15/2010, she had heard rumors about [REDACTED] knew that there had been friction between [REDACTED] and heard that [REDACTED] had been sleeping with an attorney from [REDACTED] [REDACTED] also had heard rumors that [REDACTED] had been sleeping with a manager at the [REDACTED] Restaurant. [REDACTED] expressed that she had some problems getting seated when [REDACTED] was working at the [REDACTED] back in May or June of 2010.

[REDACTED] advised she wears contacts, and is near sighted, thus can not see things far away, and on the evening of 08/15/2010 [REDACTED] did not have her contacts in.

[REDACTED] advised on 08/15/2010, at about 6:00 PM, she had come to [REDACTED] residence and then proceeded to Mitchell Park in East Moline, IL with [REDACTED] and other family members. [REDACTED] related, upon arriving at the park, [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] she thought that [REDACTED] was at the park, and thought she was with a guy who [REDACTED] thought was [REDACTED] Dad. [REDACTED] offered the male looked too young to be [REDACTED] Dad and thought the guy looked like he was 36 or 37 years old. [REDACTED] described the male as 36-37 years old, wearing eye-glasses, khaki shorts, had facial hair and a mustache, dark hair, and was driving a Corvette.

[REDACTED] offered, when she returned home, her mother [REDACTED] asked her to look at an internet picture of Jeff Terronez. [REDACTED] advised she thought he looked similar to the guy she observed at the park, but due to her vision could not be positive.

[REDACTED] indicated she had taken a picture of [REDACTED] and the guy, and would send the picture to my phone. A copy of the cell phone picture was transferred to my cell phone, and is attached to this investigative report. A copy of the internet website for the Rock Island State's Attorney's Office, along with Jeff Terronez's photograph is also attached to this investigative report.

NARRATIVE SECTION

The recorded interview of [REDACTED] was held on my digital recorder in my official state vehicle (OSV) after the interview. On 08/23/2010, I downloaded the interview from my digital recorder onto a CD and made two working copies. The original CD was labeled exhibit #2, and was subsequently placed in a temporary evidence storage (TES) locker at ISP, Zone 2 Investigations, Sterling, IL office (Z-2 ST). On 08/27/2010, at approximately 4:30 PM, exhibit #2 was retrieved from the TES, packaged, and placed in ISP, Z-2 ST, evidence drop locker (EDL) #20.

[REDACTED] But I mean you can see a man and a girl talking.

JC: Okay. And it, and it appeared that it, as if they were yelling at one point?

[REDACTED] Yeah.

JC: Okay. Describe the guy to me.

[REDACTED] Well, okay. He had on, he had glasses on.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] And he was in regular clothes, you know, not like business or anything. Um...

JC: Like regular, what do you mean?

[REDACTED] Like casual. Like jeans.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] Or khaki shorts, I think, and a shirt. Um...but he had a black Corvette. I do know that. Cause when they left, like he left before she left.

JC: Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] He left in a black Corvette. But I didn't...we didn't get the license plate.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] But when I got home, my mom showed me a, cause she's like, cause I heard the rumor...

[REDACTED] And, um, when I got home, I was like I don't know if it was him, but he had a really nice car, and I didn't, I don't know who could afford a Corv...brand new Corvette. And I was just like maybe it was him. And my mom showed me the guy, and it looked like just him. He had glasses, dark hair.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] Cause I couldn't see that far away, cause I didn't have my glasses on.

JC: Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] Like cause I have to see, wear my glasses, then I can see.

JC: Now what do you wear? Contacts?

[REDACTED] No.

JC: You wear eye glasses?

[REDACTED] Yeah.

JC: So you don't have 'em in now?

[REDACTED] No.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] But I have, um, prescription sunglasses that I drive with.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] But I didn't have 'em on at the park.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] Cause we were playin' basketball.

JC: So are you nearsighted or farsighted?

[REDACTED] Near. I can't see far away.

JC: Okay. And how far away do you think the guy was?

[REDACTED] They were like...okay, like when you get to, you know where Mitchell Park is, don't you?

JC: Not really, but I...

[REDACTED] Well it's like down the street from their house. When you drive up, we parked like facing this way.

JC: Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] Parked facing this way. They were like parked this way, cause you could park in a circle.

JC: Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] And we were at the basketball court, and the basketball court, you can see, I could see her car. I mean I knew it was her.

JC: Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] And I could see the guy like, if I squint, I can see.

JC: Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] So I seen him, yeah. Then I zoomed in on my camera. I could see better, but my camera takes really bad pictures on my phone.

JC: Yeah?

[REDACTED] Yeah.

JC: How old would you say the guy was?

[REDACTED] I don't know. Probably...

JC: And I'm asking you to tell me how old you thought the guy was that you seen...

[REDACTED] Well when I seen, when I seen him, I knew that he was older than me.

JC: Right.

[REDACTED] You know? He had like...

JC: You look pretty young for 21.

[REDACTED] Yeah, I know. He has facial hair, so I knew he was older than me. I think he did. I'm pretty sure like he had...(unintelligible) think.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] But I knew it had to be someone who, who was older. Not that many kids my age drive that kinda car. You know?

JC: Right.

[REDACTED] Or, I mean not that many parents drive that kinda car either.

JC: Now when you say he was older, I mean put, put...

[REDACTED] I knew he wasn't, okay, let me say. My aunt's 27. Like they're sisters. My mom and my aunt.

JC: Right.

[REDACTED] He wasn't 27. I know that. He could've been at least [REDACTED] age. [REDACTED] mom.

JC: Okay. And how old is she?

[REDACTED] I think she's 37 or 36.

JC: Okay. And you said something about he had facial hair?

[REDACTED] Yeah, I think so.

JC: Okay. Do you think he had a full beard, or do you think...

[REDACTED] I don't know. I was squinting, so I couldn't see.

[REDACTED] I don't know if [REDACTED] was watching 'em better than I was.

JC: Okay. But you're pretty sure he had a moustache?

[REDACTED] So she was just staring at me, and I was like I don't know if she's doing this cause she knows I'm [REDACTED]'s cousin, and she doesn't like me, or doesn't like [REDACTED]. But this is stupid. So I told, I told a manager, and that manager didn't do anything. So then I got another manager, and he's like well what were they doing? And I told him, and he gave us our meal free. And then like this girl that works there who I'm friends with, she's like there's rumors that she's [REDACTED] [REDACTED]...one of the managers here.

JC: Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] And then the manager that me and my friend are friends with told me she's [REDACTED] one of the managers there.

JC: And how long ago was this?

[REDACTED] This was like...I don't even know when it was actually. May or June.

JC: Okay. This year?

[REDACTED] Yeah. Cause she just got fired from there.

JC: Now this manager, does he have a Corvette?

[REDACTED] No. Probably not.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] Cause that's not him. It's definitely...this guy is kind of like, the, this, that, the guy I seen at the park wasn't big. This guy at the, the, um, [REDACTED] is kinda big.

JC: The manager...

[REDACTED] And shorter.

JC: ...at [REDACTED] is big?

[REDACTED] Yeah.

JC: Big guy? Tall, you mean? Fat? What do you...

[REDACTED] Kind of like fat and stubby.

[REDACTED] The one that I'm guessing [REDACTED] cause he didn't do anything about us when we complained, you know. He just said okay, well I'll talk to the girls. And then nothing happened. You know, that's all he said to us.

SS: So when you said you went back and told your mom...

[REDACTED] Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] Well cause I told her...because...I told her because when I told her about the guy that...

SS: Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] ...she was [REDACTED] cause [REDACTED] told me in the car, she's like, she's like so [REDACTED] in my class, and I was just...or, yes, [REDACTED] in my class, and I was like yeah, and then she's like well we told, we told each other that, she, she asked me if we could be friends, and I was like [REDACTED] don't be friends with her. She started all that stuff with you and [REDACTED] She's your sister. Don't, just don't, just ignore her. You don't have to like someone, but don't, just don't start problems with her. And she's like yeah, she told, um, [REDACTED]

SS: Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] ...that she's sleeping with the attorney. And I was like what attorney? [REDACTED] I was like that's disgusting. And I was just like that's wrong, because the attorney, I mean I'm smarter than that, and [REDACTED] is, with the whole thing.

SS: Sure.

[REDACTED] But I said that's the attorney that is getting [REDACTED] put away, whatever.

JC: Mmm-hmm.

[REDACTED] And then she's like yeah, I know. And I was like that's ridiculous. So then, um, I told my mom. I was like mom, remember when I told you that we heard [REDACTED] I was like well [REDACTED] just told me that there's a rumor she's sleeping with the attorney that turned, [REDACTED] And my mom was like what, and I was like yeah.

SS: So after the day at the park...

[REDACTED] But this was a long time ago that I told my mom.

SS: Yeah. Let me take you to the day after the park. You said that you seen a picture of him?

[REDACTED] My mom, well the day of the park...

SS: Of the park?

[REDACTED] ...my mom showed me.

SS: Okay.

[REDACTED] On the internet.

SS: On the internet?

[REDACTED] Yeah. And I was like that looks like the guy, cause he had glasses.

SS: Okay.

[REDACTED] And dark hair.

SS: Yeah.

JC: Is it possible that it wasn't the guy?

[REDACTED] I don't know.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] I mean it all, I mean it just, to me it just kinda makes sense. (Unintelligible)

JC: It kind of fits together, but...

[REDACTED] Yeah, cause it...

JC: ...if you wouldn't have heard all this stuff before...

[REDACTED] I mean...

[REDACTED] ...if I wouldn't have heard it, I probably would be like that could be any rich guy.

[REDACTED] You know? But then I seen his face, and I was just like that looks like him. You know, he resembles the guy from the park.

JC: Okay.

[REDACTED] Like I told my mom, I was like I'm not for sure, but he resembles the guy I seen. I was like he had glasses just like that guy. Okay. Yeah, it's not very good. See (unintelligible) she's sitting on the car. The red car.

JC: Who's in the white?

[REDACTED] That's the guy she's talking to. She's in the yellow. See?

JC: Okay. Boy, he looks awful skinny.

SS: You didn't get a picture of his car, did you?

[REDACTED] No. [REDACTED] told me I should've got his license plate, but he like drove off, he left before her. He drove off faster. You know?

JC: Mmm-hmm.

SS: But he wasn't wearing a hat?

[REDACTED] I don't think so.

SS: I can't tell there.

[REDACTED] Like it, I, I, that's what I said, I can't tell, but I don't think so.

SS: You don't think so?

JC: Now do you, with your black, blackberry, do you have e-mail?

[REDACTED] Havin' a cookout. There was a lot of 'em, so I don't know.

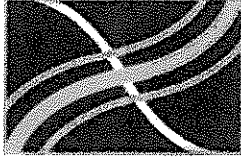

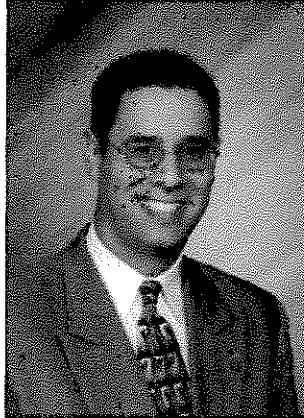
